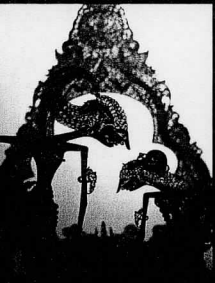
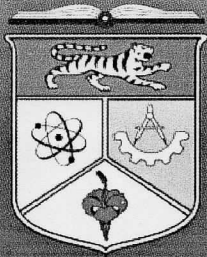

Abstract

This research aims to develop the culture of the Social Studies Education Study Program Yogyakarta State University with the characteristics of worshipping obedience, honesty, responsibility, caring, cooperation, respect for others, and independence in all the civitas academica. This research is an Action Research with the model of Kemmis & Tagart. The principal action which is implemented is "habituation" to practice the seven noble values derived from the target values of character education of Yogyakarta State University. The results showed that in the second cycle there is an improvement. The score average of the practice of the values is satisfactory. The Obedience of worship rose from 58.82 to 81.57; honesty increased from 73.57 to 86.43; responsibility increased from 69.25 to 83.68; caring increased from 66.79 to 83.64; cooperation increased from 73.39 to 85.71; respect for others increased from 75.21 to 87.43, and independence increased from 70.50 to 84.96. Overall, the scores increased from 69.65 to 84.79. Thus, the Culture of the Social Studies Education Study Program, Yogyakarta State University is characterized by the practice of the seven noble values has been realized.
