Dear valued Authors of the 3rd SCESCM,

I would like to give you an update on the publication process. We up loaded 184 papers to the Elsevier's system. Soon 165 were returned due poor pictures' quality. Most pictures were blur, had a sizes less than 300 dpi. Other issues were poor transfer from word to pdf resulting in missing symbols and notations. We decided to work on the issues ourselves, since returning them to you and awaiting corrections will take too long. We had a very short time frame.

Finally, we re-up loaded the papers. But again 88 were returned due to picture fonts that were not standardized, or vague, or, even worse, unreadable. This work took a lot more effort since we had to remove the old texts and re-type these into the papers. After re-up loading, again 55 were returned due to text that were on top of the pictures and thus not clear. Our team worked around the clock to repair these problems. And as of yesterday, we send the papers to Elsevier. Let's hope that they will now accept our work.

This is just a reminder for all of us how important it is to follow the template to the letter. We as committee also learned a lot, it will take a more restrict evaluation and paper selection system to avoid these kinds of problems in the future. For all of you who sent us questions concerning the publications, we do our best to do the process as fast as we could, but this is where we stand now.
