The education system in Indonesia has the following components. Thera is a six-Year system of primary education. This followed by three-years of junior secondary Education. Up to this level education is compulsory. Uper secondary education is Delivered in two types of institutions. The academic stream is delivered through SMU, Formely called SMA. The alternative to the academic stream is tehnical/vocational Stream, delivered through institutions which are collectively known as SMKs. However Individual SMKs specialize in particular areas and are known by their specialist titiles.

The two largest grups of SMKs deal with business studies/economics also Known as SMEAs, and with he metal/automotive/building areas which are known as STMs. SMEAs, comprise 50 per cent and STMs 38 percent of all SMK
