DIRECT & INDIRECT SPEECH

1. STATEMENT (BERITA)

He said to me "I don't have any money" He said to me that **he** didn't have any money.

2. QUESTION (PERTANYAAN)

a. Yes / No Question
They asked me, "Are you happy today?"
They asked me if / whether I was happy that day.
b. Wh Question
She asked him, "Why did you come late yesterday?"
She asked him why he had come late the day before.

3. COMMAND / PROHABITITION (PERITAH/ LARANGAN)

He ordered me, "meet me at seven tonight" He ordered me <u>to</u> meet him at seven that night.

She warned me, "Don't sit on this chair!" She warned me <u>not to</u> sit on that chair.

- Kalimat tak langsung akan mengalami perubahan tenses bila kata kerja dalam induk kalimat berbentuk past, misalnya:
- Told, said, asked etc.
 Example:
- he told me..., She said to me...., They asked her...etc.
- Andika says, "I goes to campus on Mondays".
 1. Andika says that he goes to campus on Mondays.
 2. Andika said that he went to campus on Monday.

DIRECT & INDIRECT SPEECH

- I. John said, 'I am busy today'. (direct)John said <u>that</u>..... was busy (indirect)
- II. a. He always asks me, '**When** will you get married?' He always asks me I will get married.
 - b. The host asked us, 'Will you stay the night here?'The host asked us whether / if we stay the night there.
- III. The doctor said to me, 'Have a rest for a few days and don't smoke too much'. The doctor told mehave a rest for a few days and smoke too much.
