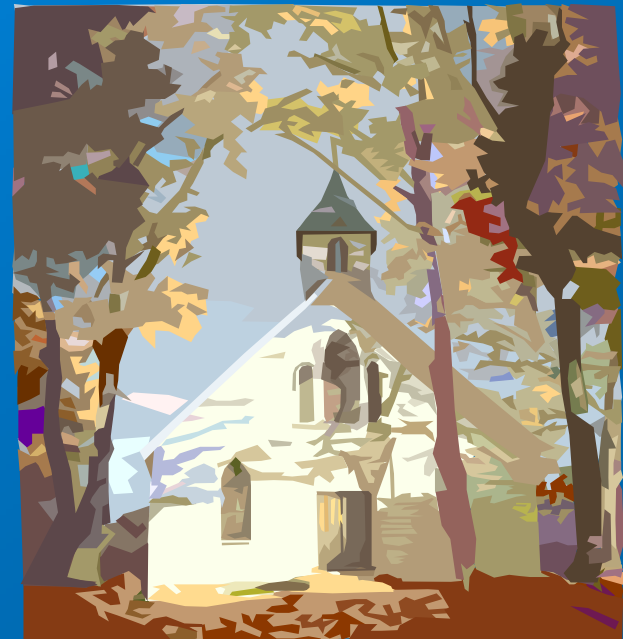

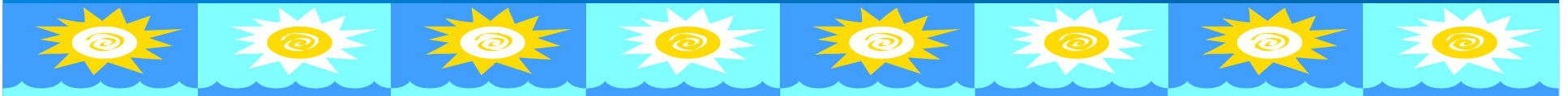

- My father (N) is (Be) **strong (adj.)**.
- My brother & father (N) are (Be) **strong (adj.)**.
  
- ❖ He is a **famous (adj.)** actor (N).
- ❖ They are **famous (adj.)** actors (N).



# Several things to discuss

- Adj. can come after the verb be (case b).
  - Adjs. Come before a N (case c).
  - Adj. DO NOT change form (case d).
  - **When a N follows an adj., use AN before the adj. begins with a vowel sound (case e).**
  - Use A before the adj. if the adj. begins with a consonant sound (case f).
  - Do not use A or AN when the adj. is not followed by a N (case g).
