

The English Sounds (Vowels, Diphthongs & Consonants)

- English has 44 sounds → can be grouped into 3
- 12 vowels
- 8 diphthongs
- 24 consonants

 Places of Articulation:bilabial, labio-dental, dental, alveolar, post-alveolar, retroflex, palato-alveolar, palatal, velar, uvular, & glotal
